

Set Departures of Northern Tanzania Safaris 2011

These set departure, eight-day safaris are not exclusively for solo travelers but they are certainly a great option for them. Their focus is to provide guests the opportunity to walk and camp in some of the remotest parts of Serengeti National Park. You hear the complaint that the Serengeti is spoiled with too many lodges and vehicles. In fact, a great deal of the park remains true wilderness, and this is where these mobiles take you.

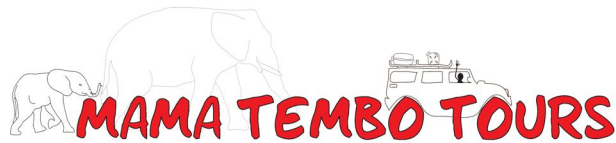
To allow bush walks in the Serengeti is a recent decision by park authorities. It is definitely one of the most exciting ones to emerge in past years. The aim of a bush walk is not to walk as far as possible. You might spend the same amount of time that you do walking just sitting quietly next to a waterhole observing what thirsty wildlife comes down to drink.

The camps are stylish and intimate. Meals are excellent. The aim is to offer a very comfortable mobile camping experience at an affordable price. If you seek great wildlife locations, experienced guiding, and truly private camping over crystal wine glasses and bathtubs, then these camping and walking mobiles are for you.



The size of the group is limited to eight participants, four people to one vehicle.

The best news is that availability remains for January and February departures, those magical months when everything is green after the short rains and the migrating herds are on the southern plains of the Serengeti on its border with the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. This is also wildebeest and zebra foaling time.



Set departures 2011:

January 16 – 23
February 13 – 20
July 10 -17
August 14 - 21



January and February Program:

Day One: You arrive Kilimanjaro International Airport, Northern Tanzania, on KLM at 8 PM. You are met and transferred to Karama Lodge in Arusha.

Day Two: You depart Arusha by road to Mtu wa Mbu village where you undertake a guided walk of the village followed by a lunch of local dishes served under the banana trees. In the afternoon, you game drive Lake Manyara National Park. You overnight at Rhotia Valley Lodge in the Ngorongoro Highlands.

Day Three: Today is a full day game drive of the Ngorongoro Crater. In mid afternoon you drive to Ndotu Safari Lodge for overnight.

Day Four: You game drive out of the Ndotu area into the Serengeti National Park proper. You take your first walk this afternoon. This is your first night in your mobile camp.

Day Five: Full day of walking. You return to camp for meals and overnight.

Day Six: Full day of walking. You return to camp for meals and overnight.

Day Seven: You game drive to the Central Serengeti area. You overnight at a lodge in the Central Serengeti.

Day Eight: You depart on a scheduled flight from the Central Serengeti to Arusha. You are given a day room at KIA Lodge next to Kilimanjaro Airport where after an early dinner you check in for your KLM departure.

(July and August camps are in different locations.)
